Meeting Core

Suquamish Tribal Police noted there have been a lot of burglaries lately all around Suquamish (especially around Augusta). Domestic violence has been increasing lately as well. Martha Burke wanted to pass thanks for supporting the local Suquamish Garden Club.

Scott Crowell provided a briefing on Suquamish Shores. The lease for current residents is up on May 31, and the Suquamish Tribe assumes the property on July 31. This year, 15 of the homes not previously removed will be removed (completed by next Spring).

Tina N. gave an update on our local County projects.

Updates:

- PTSA Report - Carol L. could not attend the most recent meeting. Kevin McD did note that SCAC discussion should include the state/age of the portables currently used at Suquamish Elementary.
- Transit update (Kevin McD). A possible change to local routing could include Indianola direct to Poulsbo (via Gunderson, Port Gamble and Lincoln). However, ridership is dropping across the majority of Kitsap Transit routing.

Final public comment:

Carol L. noted the first Sunday of every month 2-4 PM at Suquamish Museum, the "Kitsap Aware" organization is giving presentations (the most recent topic was Immigration and the upcoming topic was the rise of hate groups).


Carol L. also noted that the SCAC still needs to make a recommendation to the Kitsap Library regarding the return of the Book Mobile.


Meeting was concluded at 1950.
