Louisa Garbo gave an overview on the DCD, addressing what challenges the department faces enforcing land-use codes (Title 21 and Title 17 are challenges and DCD is trying to address these on a more periodic basis); what changes are coming up; and how all that affects Suquamish.

SCAC Work Plan for 2018 was updated. This document guides our projects and direction for next year, and an evaluation of how we've done this year. The revisions completed tonight will be proposed for approval next month.

Updates:

- Welcome to Suquamish signage. The log signage (similar to the museum) at the triangle is the proposed plan at this time.
- James ST Road End update (Tom C.): Tom C. is attempting to get a work party energized before the end of the year to finish this project.
- Kevin M. was not available to provide a transit update.
- Angeline Park and the Sports Court. A group needs to meet and determine what

needs to be done for upkeep (currently and as we move into next year).

Meeting was concluded at 2007.


