



AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM: Helpful Hints for Kitsap Residents

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a U.S. government program to help low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices like a laptop or tablet.

If your household is eligible, you could receive:



Up to a \$30/month discount on your internet service (\$75/month if your household is on qualifying Tribal lands)



A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer

To qualify for the ACP discount program your household must fulfill one of the below requirements:

1. Have a yearly household income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, as outlined below:

1 person	\$27,180	4 people	\$55,500
2 people	\$36,620	5 people	\$64,940
3 people	\$46,060	More people	Add \$9,440 each

2. Participate in certain assistance programs (SNAP, Medicaid, FPHA, SSI, WIC, Lifeline)
3. Participate in Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservation
4. Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced school lunch program
5. Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year

Check if your Internet Service Provider is participating in the ACP program and if you qualify for these helpful discounts!
