Expect delays during Agate Pass Bridge work

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND – The State Route 305 Agate Pass Bridge will be reduced to one-way alternating traffic during daytime hours for 11 consecutive days beginning Tuesday, Feb. 19. Drivers can expect at least [30-minute delays](#) during the work.

The one-way alternating traffic will allow crews to conduct an in-depth [bridge inspection](#) and maintenance.

Lane closure specifics

Each day from Tuesday, Feb. 19 through Friday, March 1, the SR 305 Agate Pass Bridge will be reduced to one alternating lane of traffic during the following times:

- 8:45 a.m. to 3 p.m. weekdays
- 7:45 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, Feb. 23-24

WSDOT needs help from drivers

- Add extra travel time when crossing the bridge during the work hours
- Consider postponing discretionary trips
- Travel early in the morning or later at night

Ferry customers are also encouraged to consider using the Bremerton or Kingston ferries.
