COVID-19 vaccines are safe, effective, and available at no cost to you.

WHO CAN GET VACCINATED?

For Phase 1b Tier 1 and Phase 1a.

- Everyone 65 or older.
- People 50 or older in multigenerational households (such as people caring for elders in their home).
- High-risk healthcare workers, first responders, and long-term care residents.

HOW TO GET VACCINATED

- Vaccine is available at some clinics, pharmacies, and hospitals in Kitsap County.
- Your doctor's office may have vaccine appointments or a wait list available.
