Burwell Street (SR 304) night paving at Warren Avenue requires detour next week

BREMERTON – Late night and early morning travelers using Burwell Street (State Route 304) in Bremerton will want to plan ahead to help prevent brief delays.

Contractor crews working for the Washington State Department of Transportation plan to close the intersection of Burwell Street and Warren Avenue (SR 303) overnight on Tuesday, Sept. 10. The closure will allow crews to repave the busy intersection. Paving activities are weather-dependent and could be rescheduled to the next dry night.

What this means for travelers

- € From 8 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 10 to 6 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 11, the intersection of Burwell Street and Warren Avenue will close;
- € Signed detour will be provided via 6th Street and Park Avenue for ferry traffic and 6th Street and Naval Ave for Burwell Street traffic;
- € No effect on ferry operations or schedule.
