Resurfacing, ADA work planned for Kitsap County highways

BREMERTON – Starting with a stretch of State Route 3 in Poulsbo, crews will soon kick off an effort to add a new roadway surface to multiple sections of three state highways in Kitsap County.

Workers will also upgrade traffic signal systems and enhance transitions from sidewalks to crosswalks, known as curb ramps, to create better sidewalk connections at a number of intersections.

State Route 3 – Poulsbo

• Repave the left lane in both directions of SR 3 and ramps generally between Northwest Luoto Road (SR 308) and Northwest Thompson Road.

SR 304 – Bremerton

• Repave Burwell Street between Warren Avenue (SR 303) and North Callow Avenue. During daytime operations, crews will keep at least one lane open in each direction.

SR 166 – Port Orchard

• Repave a portion of SR 166 generally from Bay Street to Whittier Avenue SE.

The work will begin in early April and continue into fall.
