Change of Value Notices Mailed

Phil Cook, Assessor, Kitsap County Assessor's Office – June 18, 2021 – 108,562 change of value notices will be mailed to **residential and commercial property taxpayers** on June 18, 2021.

Change of value notices are being sent to 108,562 property taxpayers throughout Kitsap County. The Assessor is required by state law to appraise property at 100% of market value. These notices are based upon property values as of January 1, 2021 and will be used when calculating property tax obligations payable in 2022.

Sales trends for the county are also available on the website as well as [sales data](#) for specific residential neighborhoods and commercial property class types. Information regarding the various property tax exemption programs is also available.
