**North Mason School District No. 403**

**General Obligation  
Bonds - \$49,000,000**

The Board of Directors of North Mason School District No. 403 adopted resolution No. 08-G-13, concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to construct a new high school with comprehensive facilities, renovate and modernize the existing high school as a middle school, install replacement roofs for schools, undertake improvements to playfields, add mechanical, safety and security upgrades throughout the district; to issue \$49,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 25 years; and to levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 08-G-13.
