**SUQUAMISH REGIONAL STORMWATER TREATMENT FACILITY DESIGN**

The Kitsap County Department of Public Works-Stormwater Division is soliciting proposals from consulting firms with experience in Civil Engineering, Geotechnical Exploration, Design, Environmental Mitigation, Stormwater Management, Landscape Architecture, Drainage Analysis, Public Outreach and Regulatory Permit Processing. The consultant will design a regional stormwater treatment facility in Suquamish WA. The facility will be designed to provide water quality (WQ) treatment for approximately 175 acres of existing older development that currently flows directly to Puget Sound with little or no treatment. The facility will be designed using a Green Stormwater Solutions (GSS) approach consistent with current treatment approaches and standards. Kitsap County Public Works (KCPW) and the Suquamish Tribe will team on this project. The project is partially funded by a grant from WA-Ecology
