In response to questions received, the following information is provided to assist in responding to the above referenced proposal:

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

1. Question: Is there an estimate of how many mobile collection event services would be required?

Answer: Historically, Kitsap County has held one (1) mobile collection event each calendar year. Kitsap County reserves the right to either not hold a mobile collection event or to budget for more than one mobile collection event in any given year during the term of services awarded under this procurement.

2. Question: Why is the site walk restricted to only one person per company?

Answer: The optional site visit at the HHW Collection Facility was limited to one (1) representative from each potential respondent team to comply with social distancing guidelines at the time of publication for this procurement. After the issuance of Proclamation 20-25 by the Washington State Governor, Addendum 1 was released canceling the optional site visit.

3. Question: Do you anticipate having a pre bid walk post SIP measures?

Answer: The HHW Collection Facility is closed in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and Proclamation 20-25 by the Washington State Governor. Press releases regarding the closure of Kitsap County's waste facilities in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and Proclamation 20-25 are posted on the Kitsap County website: <https://www.kitsapgov.com/Pages/CountyNews.aspx> . Persons who are not deemed as essential workforce to the essential functions of the facility will not be authorized onsite until Kitsap County reopens the HHW Collection facility. This is to comply with Proclamation 20-25. The site visit in RFP 2020-116 was optional and is not considered essential to bid submittal. It will not be rescheduled.

4. Question: Do you anticipate this extending the bid due date?

Answer: Currently, the County does not anticipate extending the bid due date.
