In response to questions received, the following information is provided to assist in responding to the above referenced proposal:

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

- 1. Question: The RFP states that all equipment must not be older than four years at the start of the contract, is this equipment only at the transfer station?**

Answer:

The four (4) year old average age limit on each category of equipment as of June 2022 applies to the rolling stock equipment (such as containers, front loaders, top-picks, trailers, tractors, etc.) that are assigned exclusively to Olympic View Transfer Station (OVTS) and are not regularly used for other work unrelated to OVTS operation.

So for example, this would not apply to equipment at the disposal site which handles waste from many sources, or to railroad equipment used to transport waste containers from OVTS or an alternate intermodal facility to the disposal site, or to top-pick equipment at an alternate intermodal facility that also handles containers from other sources.

While the equipment this requirement applies to would likely be physically located at OVTS, it's possible some of it might be staged or parked at a site other than OVTS – such as tractors and chassis that are used to haul containers from OVTS to an alternate intermodal facility.
