ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

The Court is undergoing a desperately needed change to its case management system. The current system is very old and experiencing daily issues and failures impacting the function of the court. The current system is on the verge of collapse. A new system has been built and will go live on August 14, 2023. In order for the system to go live on this date, data needs to be transferred from the old system to the new system and be reviewed for accuracy. In order for the court to successfully transfer data, test the transferred data for accuracy and begin operations on August 14, 2023, the court will need to temporarily cease day-to-day court operations for approximately one (1) judicial day. We will be utilizing weekend days for data transfer and testing in order to avoid closing additional court calendars.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED UNDER GENERAL RULE (GR) 21, that the Kitsap County District Court, located at 614 Division Street in Port Orchard Washington, shall be closed from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on August 10, 2023 and from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on August 11, 2023 to facilitate the upgrade of the court's case management system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the closure on August 10, 2023 and August 11, 2023 shall be construed as a non-judicial day as prescribed under Article 4, Section 6 of the Washington State Constitution, RCW 3.30.040.
