HOW DO I GET STARTED?

In some situations, it may be possible to remove a bulkhead completely and restore the shoreline to its natural state. Bulkheads are often a legacy of the past, installed because they were considered the best option at the time. Now that there is a better understanding of coastal geology and beach dynamics, we know that bulkheads are not always the best or only option for handling erosion. BULKHEAD DOWNSIDES

- Limits beach access
- Coarsens adjacent beaches
- Degrades waterfront habitat
- Cuts off Sediment

Supply

- Deflects waves, which encourages more erosion
- Degrades over time
- Expensive to repair
- Cuts off sand and gravels
