Projects Funded in 2022



Finn Creek Restoration Design – take a creek out of a ditch, reconnect it with shoreline, address flooding and community concerns.



Rose Point Embayment Restoration – remove a creosote bulkhead and reconnect a stream.



Crabapple Carpenter Creek Estuary Protection – purchase 50 acres to forever protect 50 acres of prime estuary for migrating Chinook (King) salmon to rest and feed.
