TO ADDRESS COVID-19 SITUATION

April 1, 2020

Per Governor Inslee's Open Public Meetings Act Proclamation Order, the Kitsap County Hearing Examiner will be holding all public hearings remotely until further noticed.

Applicant(s), public, and assigned planner(s) may link into the hearing through video conference, or telephonically through a call-in number. Please visit the Kitsap County Hearings Examiner website for the video conference link and/or call-in number or contact the Hearing Examiner Clerk, Amanda Walston at awalston@co.kitsap.wa.us for the above information, as well as if you have procedural questions.

With the remote process, the public may watch/listen to the hearing, and provide verbal comment, when recognized and called upon by the Examiner or Clerk, during the public comment portion. The record will be kept open for written comment for one-week following the hearing.

This Emergency Rule will remain in effect until social distancing restrictions and state orders on public gatherings are lifted.
