PROGRAMMATIC DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: <u>Update to Kitsap Countywide Planning Policies (CPPs)</u>. The proposed update is intended to ensure consistency with PSRCs Vision 2050 and any changes to state laws, such as the Washington State Growth Management Act (GMA). The CPPs apply to jurisdictions located within Kitsap County and local comprehensive plans must be consistent with them. The proposed CPPs recommended by KRCC amend: the Introduction; Elements A - N; and Appendices A, C, D, F, and G. Following Kitsap County's initial action, the adopting ordinance will be transferred to the Cities of Bainbridge Island, Poulsbo, Bremerton, and Port Orchard for ratification. At minimum, three Kitsap cities must ratify for the County adopting ordinance to take effect.


