Advocacy

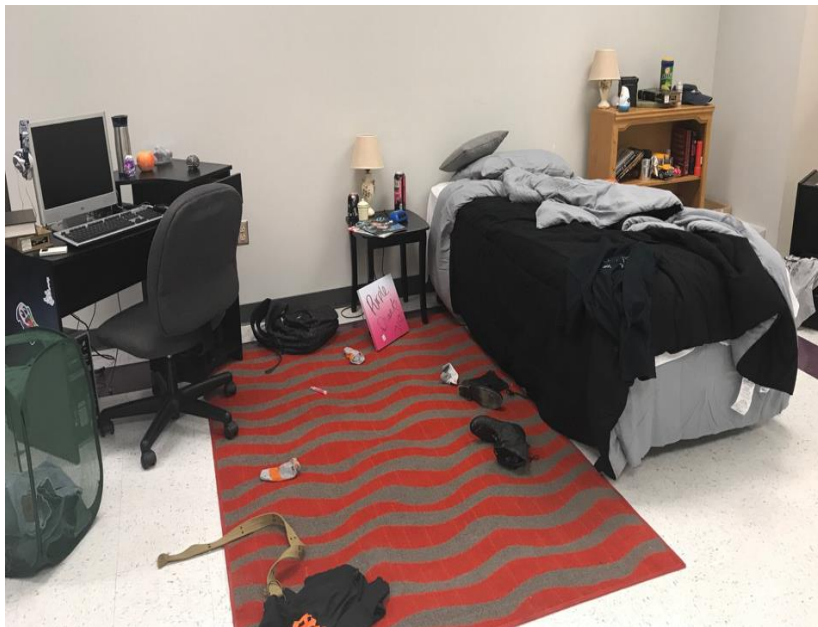
- Evaluate laws, rules, regulations and policies as to their effect on children and youth. Educate decision makers and the public about the impact of these decisions.
