### MINUTES MAY 2, 2019

The Kitsap County Commission on Children and Youth meeting was held on Thursday, May 2, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. at Olympic Educational Service District 114 in Bremerton. Jeff Allen, the Board Chairperson facilitated this meeting and called the meeting to order. Laura Hyde served as staff and recorder.

#### I. **INTRODUCTIONS**

#### II. **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES/AMENDMENTS TO THE AGENDA**

The April 2019 Minutes were reviewed and approved.

#### III. **FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS**

Charles Stevenson presented the grant application review committee's recommendations for funding the 2019 grants.

#### IV. **VOTE- GRANT FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

A vote was held of the Board Members present and the recommendations of the grant application review committee were accepted. The following recommendations will be made to the Board of County Commissioners. Funding total \$27,500 Eastside Baby Corner West Sound - \$4,000; Kitsap Community Resources- \$5,000; Coffee Oasis - \$4,400; Kitsap Strong- \$5,100; Bremerton Backpack Brigade- \$ 9,000.

#### V. **DEBRIEF GRANT AWARD SELECTION PROCESS**

The RFP and grant application review and selection process were debriefed. It was agreed to review the RFP for possible revisions.

#### VI. **YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS**
