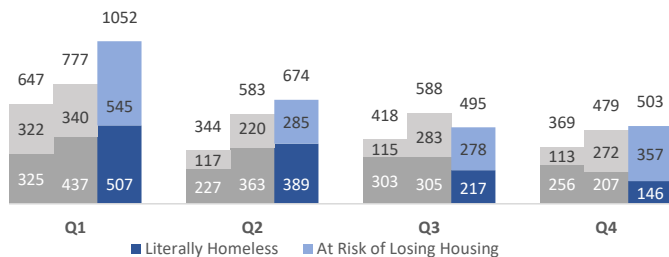

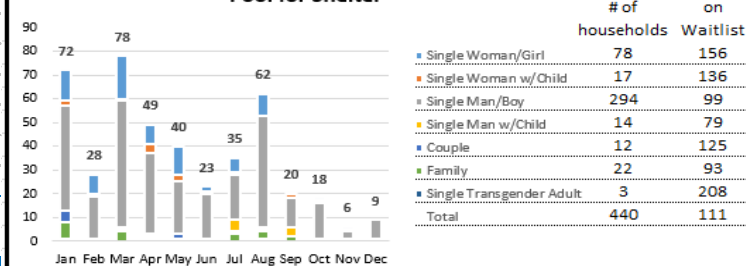
HSC Quarterly Enrollments by Household

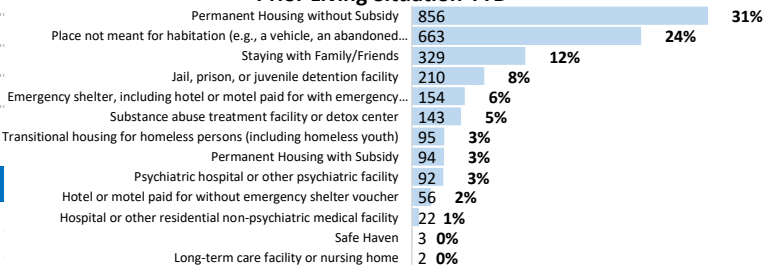

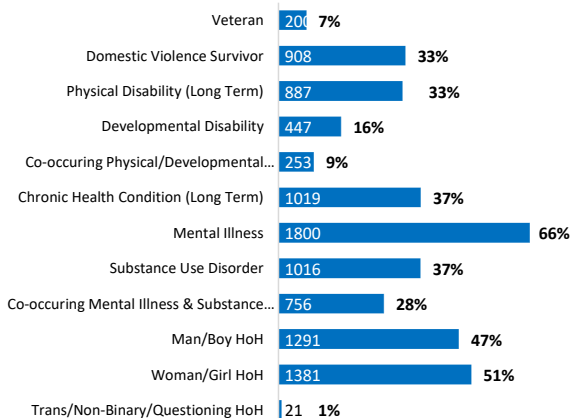

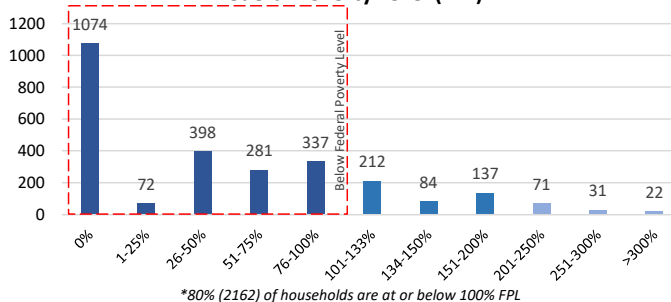
Prior Living Situation YTD



SELF-REPORTED CHARACTERISTICS¹



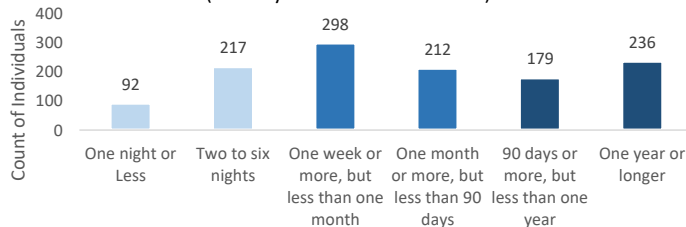
HSC Household Income Compared to Federal Poverty Level (FPL)

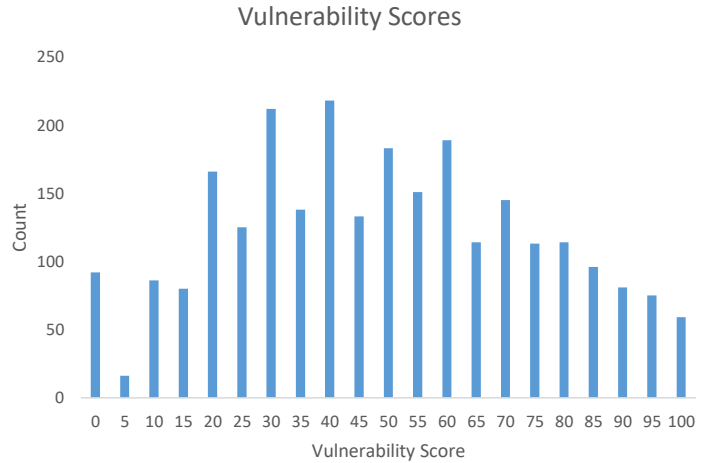

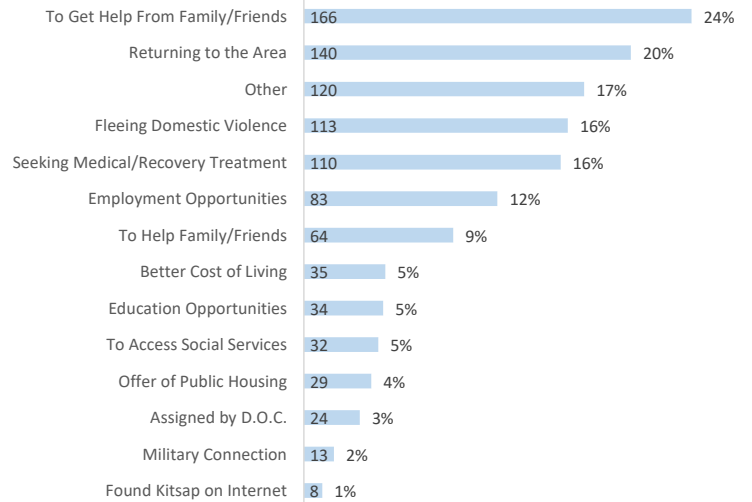

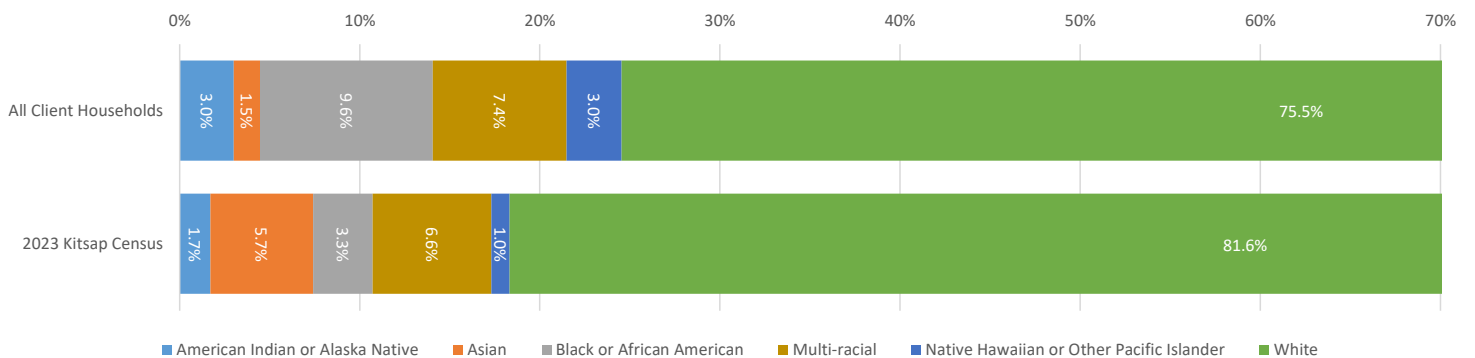


WHAT BRINGS HOUSEHOLDS ENTERING FROM OUTSIDE KITSAP

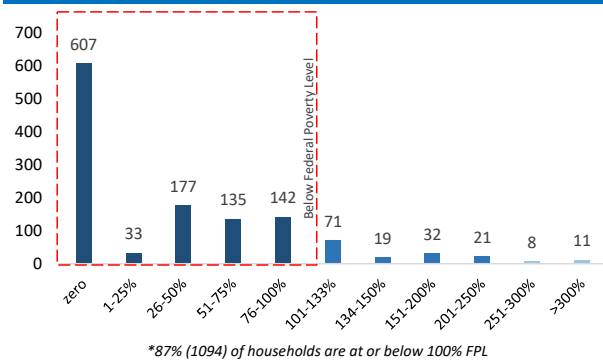

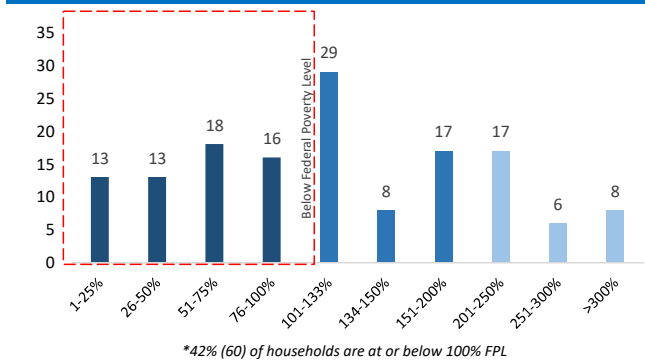

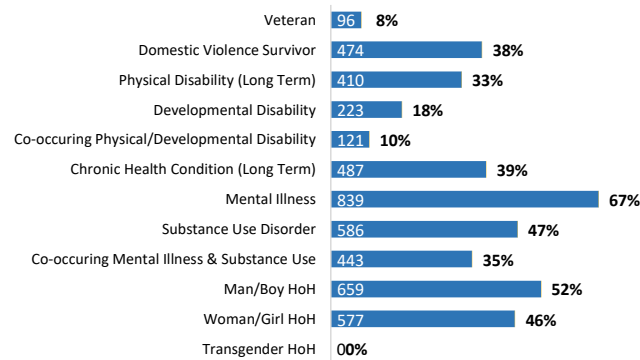
LITERALLY HOMELESS HH FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL



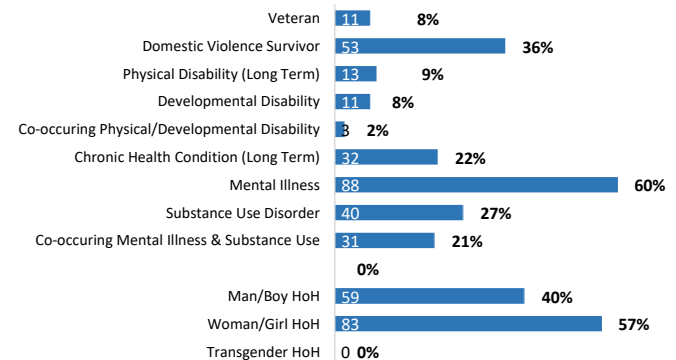
LITERALLY HOMELESS HH w/EI FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL

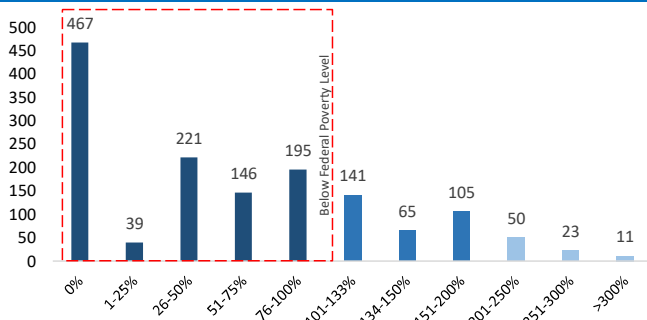

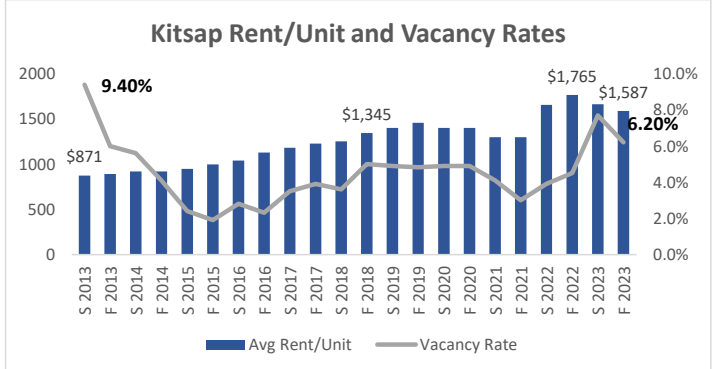

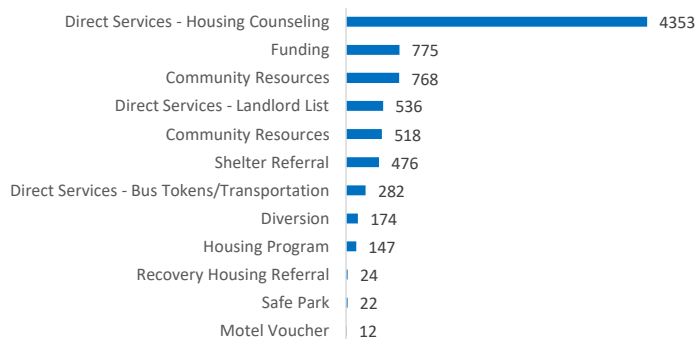

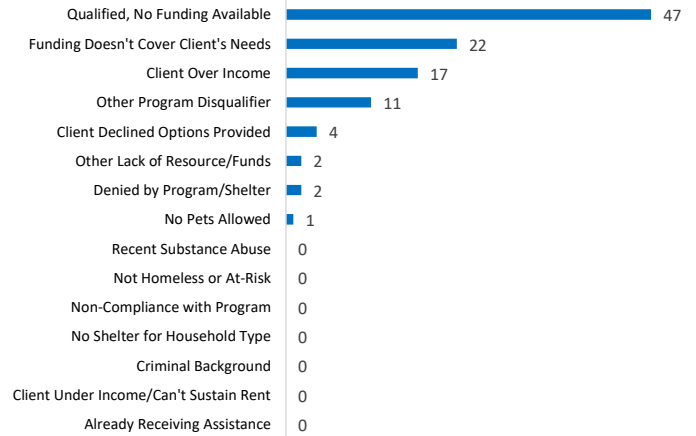
