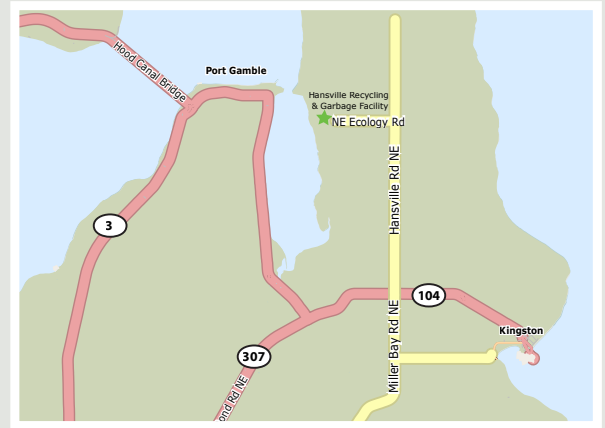

CENTRAL KITSAP (Silverdale)

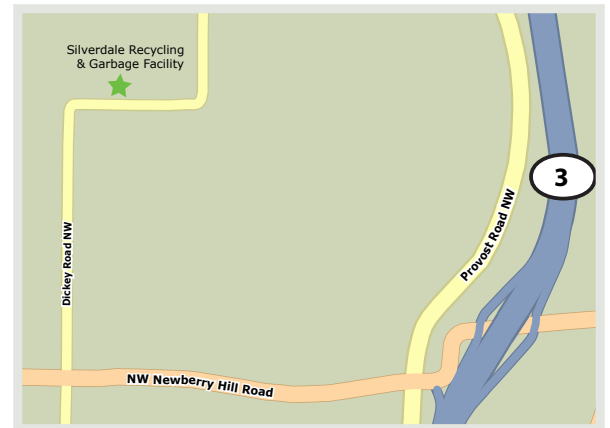
