WHEREAS, the Kitsap County Department of Public Works/Solid Waste Division (SWD) has conducted an assessment of the County owned solid waste facilities and has developed a six-year capital facilities plan for financing solid waste facility improvements for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2027 and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners has held a public hearing this 22nd day of November, 2021,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners, that the attached Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan for Kitsap County Department of Public Works/Solid Waste Division be adopted as set forth in detail, for the period mentioned, which are incorporated and made part of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a)(iv) and KCC 21,08,040, the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners hereby incorporates portions of the SWD Program Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan into the Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan. Capital-Facilities Plan. This incorporation by reference replaces and updates the Solid Waste section, specifically the subsection entitled "Solid Waste Capital Facilities Projects 2021-2026". The portions of the SWD Program Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan that are incorporated are only those components necessary for the Capital Facilities Plan, as set forth in the current Capital Facilities Plan.
