



Title 26 Guardian ad Litem Fee Schedule

Any deposits made will be kept in a client trust account and the funds still belong to the party making the deposit until billed and transferred. Billings will be monthly or as appropriate with transfer from the client trust account if no objection is made by a party after billing received. If all the deposit is not used, then a refund will be issued based on as directed in court order, or, if no court order, then in the relative proportions the deposit(s) were made.

Initial Deposit: \$3,000 payable by cash, money order, or bank check, and must be received, in full, before work commences, unless otherwise authorized by myself.

Trial Deposit: \$500 additional deposit, if funds remain in trust, or a deposit in an amount necessary to bring the trust account to \$500, to be paid forty-five days prior to trial.

Hourly Rate: \$200 per hour; billing done in 1/10th of an hour and including travel time.

Costs: Printing or copying is charged at \$0.25 per page. Actual costs of gaining records, background checks, and other necessary expenses charged against deposit at actual cost.


