Title 26 Guardian Ad Litem Fee Schedule

Any deposits made will be kept in client trust account and the funds still belong to the party making the deposit until billed and transferred. Billings will be monthly, or as appropriate, with the transfer from the client trust account if no objection is made by the party after billing is received. If all the deposit is not used, then a refund will be issued based on as directed in court order, or, if no court order, then in the relative proportions in which the deposit(s) were made.

- Initial Deposit:** \$2,500.00 payable by cash, money order, or bank check, and must be received before work commences.
- Amount of Billing without Court Approval:** An additional \$2,500 (for a total of \$5,000) shall be authorized without further Court Approval.
- Trial Deposit:** \$500.00 additional deposit, if funds remain in trust, or a deposit in an amount necessary to bring the trust account to \$500.00, to be paid forty-five (45) days prior to trial.
- Hourly Rate:** \$200.00 per hour; billing done in 1/6th of an hour increments. Billing includes travel time.
- Costs:** Printing or copying is charged at \$0.25 per page. Actual costs of gaining records, background checks, and other necessary expenses are charged against deposits by clients at actual cost.


