

BAR COMPLAINTS

To the best of my recollection, I have received 2 bar complaints. I do not have a copy of either complaint.

1. Approximately 1988, I was a deputy prosecuting attorney in Jefferson County. I prosecuted a young man for murder. After sentencing, the father made false allegations that I was overzealous. Complaint dismissed without investigation.
2. Approximately 1995, I successfully represented a father in a child support modification. He complained that our bills failed to credit payments. After responding that bills only showed activity for the previous month; and that payments made after the first of the month would appear as credits on that month's bill, the client apologized and withdrew his complaint.

MALPRACTICE SUITS

I've been sued once for malpractice. *Zwicker v Olsen & McFadden*, Kitsap County Superior Court No. 10-2-02887-2. Client missed statute of limitations after I advised him of incorrect statute. Case settled by our insurer.


