Sheriff John Gese takes great pleasure in announcing the promotion of Lieutenant Ken Dickinson to his new rank, effective on Monday, December 6th. Lieutenant Dickinson will be assigned to the Support Services Division.

Lieutenant Dickinson is a native of Lyndhurst, Virginia. He graduated from Stuarts Draft High School in 1983 and Western Washington University in 2004 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Human Services.

Lieutenant Dickinson is a veteran of the United States Navy, having served as an Auxiliary Division Machinist Mate aboard the attack submarine USS Whale (SSN-638) and Trident Ballistic Missile Submarine USS Michigan (SSBN-727 Gold). He served from 1984-1990 and attained the rank of Petty Officer Second Class (MM2/SS).

He began his career at the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office in January of 1994 and served as a Patrol Deputy from 1994-2000. He was assigned to the Traffic Investigation Unit from 2000-2012 where he attained certification as a collision reconstructionist.

Dickinson was promoted to Sergeant in 2012 and assigned to the Patrol Division as a Shift Supervisor from 2012-2014 and again from 2018-2021. Dickinson served as the Civil/Supports Services Sergeant from 2015-2018 and again in 2021, the position he has held until his promotion to Lieutenant.

Lieutenant Dickinson has also served as a Field Training Officer, Marine Services Unit Deputy and Supervisor and Public Information Officer. He is a 2020 graduate of Leadership Kitsap.
