3.22.22 Bidders Conference for RFP: Programs that Prevent and Reduce the Impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences through Building Resiliency

- 1. Q Is the application submitted on a portal system or by paper?
  - A We are currently accepting paper applications only. A flash drive must be submitted with the application. Detailed information is in section IV of the RFP.
- 2. Q Do they ever consider funding more than one project?
  - A In the last 3 years multiple projects have been funded.
- 3. Q If we want to do more than one thing should we do separate applications?
  - A You may include multiple activities in your agency's application or submit multiple applications with separate projects.
- 4. Q What can we use for the cash match?
  - A There is a description and some examples of what may be used as the 100% private match in section II of the RFP and slide # 18 of the Bidders Conference Slide Deck.
- 5. Q What projects were funded last year?
  - A Kitsap Strong was funded for a Trauma Informed Refresher Training for school staff. Eastside Baby Corner West Sound was funded to increase the number of children served by their basic needs' assistance program. The Boys & Girls Clubs of South Puget Sound was funded to create calming corners and emotional regulation stations for youth at the clubs.
- 6. Q When are the applications due?
  - A Applications are due in the Kitsap County Purchasing Department office on April 14, 2022 by 3pm.
