- (3) Serve this motion and the Vehicle Impound Note For Motion Docket on all other parties; and
- (4) After a party is served, complete a Vehicle Impound Declaration Of Service for each party served; and
- (5) File each Vehicle Impound Declaration Of Service with the Court.
