18-00716: Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network – New Wireless Communication Facility, Conditional Use Permit (CUP)

Project Description: The Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network is proposing to construct a wireless telecommunication facility which is includes a 194-foot lattice tower with 4 antennas and 2 microwave dishes on the tower as reviewed under KCC 17.530.060. The request includes 50' x 50' fenced compound which will include a pre-manufactured equipment shelter with an emergency backup generator. The primary purpose of the new tower is to improve emergency radio coverage on the west side of Vashon Island, which is in King County.

18-02700: Foster Shoreline Variance, Shoreline Variance (SVAR)

Project Description: The proposal is a shoreline variance application to reduce the required 50-foot reduced standard shoreline buffer by an additional 25 feet. The request is due to the small size of the property, septic drainfield and reserve requirements, and narrow depth of the property. The request is the minimum necessary to provide relief for the construction of a residence and small garage on this platted shoreline property. Mitigation planting is required.
